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Vicksburg's favorite way to cross the river and one of the most exciting fundraising events in our state is here! We are **inviting you to participate in this event**, where people from around the south will gather to enjoy selections from the best restaurants in West Central Mississippi!

Please mark your calendar for **Thursday, November 6th at 6 PM** to be one of the restaurants showcased at this year's event on The Old Mississippi River Bridge.

### Reasons to Participate:

- 100% of all ticket sales will go directly to United Way of West Central Mississippi to be distributed to local programs and initiatives in our community.
- You receive promotional opportunities by being listed on our website, social media accounts, signage highlighting your restaurant on the bridge, and listed on our event t-shirt. Your restaurant will be announced in the newspaper and on the radio.
- We will provide all tables, tents, lighting, and signage. Your logo will be displayed on the tent you are serving at.

### What to Expect in 2025:

- Number of tickets to be sold is 800.
- We will have two staggered but consecutively running serving lines, serving approximately 400 patrons each.
- Each serving section will contain the same restaurants serving the same food in the same
  order. What does this mean for you? It means you will serve your food to two smaller groups.
   Since this requires you to have staff at two different locations, we will happily provide culinary
  students and SOTS volunteers to help serve as needed.
- To help with portion control, we are asking that the restaurants serve the patrons instead of the patrons self-serving. Each restaurant will have a prep table, a "holding" table, and a table where you will serve your four-ounce serving. Restaurants can have their food pre-prepped on the prep and holding tables, but will hand the patron their food across the serving table. Do not forget serving utensils if your food item requires it.





- Two restaurants will share a tent, and traffic will be "routed" via barriers between the tent groups/ There will be seating after every two tent groups.
- Patrons will be provided a disposable tray at the start of their serving line to help transport food.
- We will provide a banner at each tent with your logo
- In the event of inclement weather, we will postpone the event to Tuesday, November 11, 2025.
